Tony Carrico made a motion for the second reading of B&O tax revision. Bill Mullins seconded, and the vote was unanimous.


Christmas baskets will be delivered 12/13/2024. Purchased from Save A Lot at \$11.00 a basket. Town will purchase 105 baskets.

Ronald Nelson made the motion to reinstate Jerry Browns salary. Mark Snow seconded the motion, and the vote passed unanimously.


George Chafin made the motion to review the budget (FY 25, Fund 01, Rev 2) . Mark Snow seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Ronald Nelson made a motion for Christmas attendance incentive set the same as last year. George Chafin seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimously passed.


Tony Carrico made a motion to hand out Christmas baskets to the elderly of the town. George Chafin seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimously approved.

Mark Snow made the motion to move next months meeting to November 12th. Ronald Nelson seconded, and the vote was unanimous.




Jim Accruso and Glenda Rodriguez made council aware of Flood Disaster Loans. Deadline @ Madison City Hall November 2nd 6days/week.

Mayor gave update on Versa Court.







The council discussed Versa Court being shipped.



Mark Snow made the motion to buy the Versa Court with one bid at \$32,023.00. Bill Mullins seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous.





Bill Mullins made the motion to approve the budget revision (FY 2024 fund 01, Revision 04) Ronald Nelson seconded, and the vote was unanimous.


Jerry Brown reported he called CSX trying to get property for softball field in Bob Gee Park.

The bidding process for roof repairs had two bids – PAR Roofing was \$28,900 and DMS Properties \$ 9,360


The bidding process for the window facings only had one bid – Richard Eldridge, LLC \$8,000.00




Justin Chafin gave update on fire department.



2. Repair and replacement of the roof of the community center




